IFebruary 2025 marked the third time we have been in Honduras giving out school supplies to children. In those three years, God has grown the ministry of PEH in ways that we could have never imagined. Because of God's provision and His Plan, we are blessing children and teachers in nine schools in Copan with school supples, a feeding program, vitamins and anti-parasites, and a clean water system. Praise be to God for all he is doing.

Clean water is essential for the health of any child. In the US, we have lots of access to clean water rght out of our faucets in our house. However, access to clean water is rare. The water the children drink at school is the same water that they use for bathing and cooking. It is also the same water that animals use. While at school, the chidlren will always have clean water to drink. In addition, every day they attend school, they will receive vitamins and every six months they will receive antiparisite medicines. The parents and teachers were so excited that God is providing for the health of their children.









School Supplies for Children and Teachers!

In Copan and the surrounding area, we were able to bless 625 children with backpacks and pencil pouches filled with supplies. In addition, 33 teacher were blessed with bags full of supplies. Two of the villages, San Isidro and Hacienda San Juan, have never been blessed to get school supplies. We are so excited to see God grow our relationships in these two communities.

In addition to the school supplies, clean water kits, and medicines, the teachers and children were also blessed with a first aid kit that will remain at the school. Everything from Ibuprofen and Tylenol to Cortizone Cream, Antacids, Antibiotic Ointment, and bandages of all kinds were in the box. It will be a great tool for the teachers, as they seek to make sure all the needs of the children are met and they can learn.
